'Graduate Studies' Programs At The Faculty of Education Mansoura University, Egypt

There is a number of 'Graduate Studies' programs at the Faculty of Education, Mansoura University, Egypt. These programs are as follows:

1. The "General Diploma in Education" Program

- * This program aims at the educational qualification of the graduates of the non-educational colleges and higher institutes (or those of equivalent certificates) to practice teaching at the pre-university levels.
- * This program allows the graduates who got B.A. or B.Sc. or an equivalent degree of a credited institute to be admitted.
- * Applicants for this program should pass the interview held by the faculty.
- * The duration of the study in this program is one academic year for full-time applicants and two academic years for practicing pre-university teachers.

7. The "Professional Diploma in Education" Program

- * This program aims at qualifying graduates of the faculties of education in one of the specializations offered by the Faculty.
- * Applicants who got the B. A., B.Sc., or the General Diploma from one of the Egyptian universities or have an equivalent degree, or those who got an equivalent certificate will be admitted.
- * Study in this program follows the semester system and the credit hour system can be applied too, when possible.
- * The duration of the study in this program is one academic year in one of the following specializations:

***.** "Special Diploma in Education" Program

- * This program aims at qualifying applicants for the educational specialization to be enrolled in and also for equipping them with the basics of scientific research in this field.
- * Applicants should have the degree of the "Professional Diploma in Education" so that they can be enrolled in one of the following specializations:

A. Dept. of Educational Foundations:

Educational Foundations Educational Administration & Quality Assurance

B. Dept. of Educational Psychology:

Educational Psychology Mental Hygiene Special Education

C. Dept. of Curriculum & Instruction:

Curriculum & Instruction

D. Dept. of Educational Technology:

Educational Technology

- * The academic department conducts an admission exam the applicants should pass in written and oral English.
- * The study follows the credit hour system in which applicants study
- redit hours divided between two semesters or more up to a maximum of four semesters, as the minimum number of courses in one semester is three and the maximum is five.

4. "Master's Degree in Education" (M.A.) Program

- * Applicants should have the 'Special Diploma in Education' from one of the Egyptian universities or an equivalent degree with overall grade of "Good" at least, besides having a Bachelor of Arts & Education with an overall grade of "Good" at least.
- * Enrollment applications for this program are submitted twice a year (in *November* and *April*).
- * The duration of study in this program is one year at least, starting when the University Council of Graduate Studies & Research approves the topic, and the maximum is three years.
- * M. A. theses submitted by enrolled researchers shall be defended only after meeting the following requirements:
- Passing the two specialized courses determined by the academic department; three credit hours each and these are as follows:
- a) Advanced course in the general specialization of the academic department.
 - b) Advanced course in the specialization of the thesis topic.

(Note: Researchers can pass the two specialized courses in one semester or more.)

* Passing the TOEFL or DELF foreign language tests. The Faculty Council determines the required level after consultation with the department councils.

. "Doctorate of Philosophy in Education" (Ph.D.) Program

- * Applicants should have the Master's degree (M.A.) in Education in one of the educational specializations from one of the Egyptian universities or an equivalent degree with overall grade of "Good" at least.
- * Enrollment applications for this program are submitted twice a year (in *November* and *April*).
- * The duration of study in this program is two academic years at least, starting when the University Council of Graduate Studies & Research approves the topic, and the maximum is four years. The Faculty Council may extend the enrollment for new periods based upon the supervisors' reports and the approval of the Department Council.
