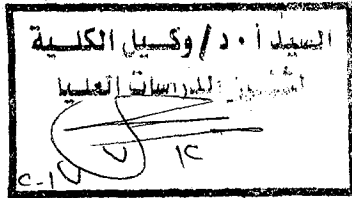

INTRODUCTION & BACKGROUND

Aiming towards Bridging the Gap between Academia, Government and Industry for better Engineering and Environmental Sustainability. Realizing the vital importance of such challenges, the Faculty of Engineering, Alexandria University, is hosting its 11th International Conference "Role of Engineering towards A Better Environment RETBE 17". The theme of the conference this year will be "Bridging the Gap between academia, government and industry". The conference will be held on December 18-20, 2017, in Alexandria, Egypt. It continues to uphold the mission of its preceding successful conferences that started about 20 years ago, by a series of successful RETBE conferences emphasizing the challenges facing the environment and the need to innovative environmental actions and policies.

The conference compares Business as Usual (BAU) scenarios with Green Environment Vision (GEV) scenarios, contrasting the economic, public health reliability and environmental impacts of engineering development paths. As an important and timely worldwide issue, the conference will be hosting side workshops and three working groups in (Water & Sanitation - Energy & Environmental Pillars - Sustainable Cities & Human Settlements) towards Alexandria 2030.

This conference will convene leading scientists and engineers to address and advance the environmental security agenda in different fields of engineering and build partnerships across theory, policy and practice.

SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACTS

Authors from all disciplines are invited to submit an electronic version of a 250-words abstract of the paper on one or more of the conference topics. It should include the title of the paper, name(s) and affiliation(s) of author(s), complete mailing address(es), electronic mail(s) and fax number(s). The abstract should also include work objective(s) and main conclusions.

CONFERENCE OBJECTIVES

The main objectives of RETBE'17 are:

- To address environmentally sound water resources issues, and waste management.
- To promote creative ideas in urban planning; buildings and construction; and land use management to explore needs for smart cities.
- To discuss the environmental impact of global warming and climate changes especially sea level rise.
- To initiate environmental policies considering the needs of introducing nuclear and renewable energy sources.
- Sustainable Infrastructure in Egypt, and needs for research and future collaboration between Egypt & USA will be explored by the University of Alabama at Birmingham.
