POST OF DIRECTOR

The Utility Regulatory Authority (URA) of the Republic of Mauritius is inviting applications for the post of Director to be responsible for the execution of the policy of the Authority, for the implementation of the decisions of the Board, and more generally for carrying out the day-to-day management and administration of the Authority.

The primary responsibility of the Director include, but is not limited to, the economic regulation of electricity and water services as well as wastewater disposal services, as provided for in the Utility Regulatory Authority Act, 2004.

The URA is an independent body and its objects are to ensure the sustainability and viability of utility services; protect the interests of both existing and future customers; promote efficiency in both operations and capital investments in respect of utility services; and promote competition to prevent unfair and anti-competitive practices in the utility services industry. Its main functions are to implement the policy of Government relating to applicable utility services; grant, vary and revoke licenses in respect of utility services; enforce the conditions laid down in an undertaking authorization, regulate tariffs and other charges levied by a licensee; mediate or arbitrate disputes between customers and licensees; establish and implement adequate systems for monitoring the compliance by licensees with standards and applicable regulations and making such information publicly available; protect the interest of customers in relation to any utility services; and examine and make recommendations to a licensee in respect of any Power Purchase Agreement.

The Director shall have the following core competencies:-

- A postgraduate degree in regulatory policy, management, finance, economics or engineering, with at least ten years' experience at senior management level in regulatory practices relating to electricity or water services or wastewater disposal services;
- Comprehensive knowledge of regulatory issues and structures pertaining to regulated utility services in the energy and/or water sector, including licensing, dispute resolution, competition issues, safety and reliability standards, tariffs, consumer protection and contract administration;
- Proven track record in organisational leadership and public administration and managing a professional organisation;
- Demonstrated analytical thinking and negotiation skills;
- Sound understanding of the electricity and water industries, with knowledge of electricity and water laws; knowledge and experience of electricity and water sector issues in small island economies would be an advantage;
