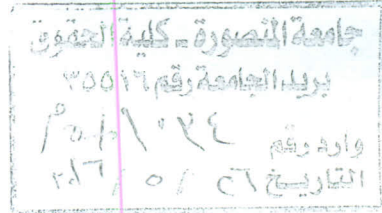

Please read these instructions carefully before completing the application.

STEP 1: Learn the requirements for submitting an application

Eligibility Requirements

- Egyptian citizenship; holders of U.S. green cards and/or passports are ineligible
- Academic staff of an Egyptian university or research institute/center
- Professional and academic staff in the field of Arts Management, holding an academic position at an Egyptian university or managerial/administrative position in artistic institution e.g. museum, library, arts, cultural center/institute, etc...
- Ph.D. for research grants.
- B.A./B.Sc., MFA or Ph.D. for Arts Management grants.
- Excellent command of English.

Eligible Fields: ALL fields are eligible with the EXCEPTION of medical fields including clinical research.

Foreign Language Teaching Assistant Program (FLTA)

Program Overview:

The FLTA program is a nine-month non-degree program aimed at strengthening foreign language instruction at U.S. colleges, universities and some high schools, while providing young Egyptian teachers of English as a second language (ESL), as well as teachers of American studies, literature, and journalism and media studies, with opportunities to refine their skills, increase their English language proficiency, and expand their knowledge of American society. FLTA fellows serve as Teaching Assistants, teaching up to two Arabic classes. They also enroll in at least two courses per semester, one of which must be U.S. studies. The remaining coursework must relate to their specializations. They will also be expected to facilitate cultural events, language clubs and language tables. FLTA fellows also interact with their host communities in conversation groups, extracurricular activities, and community outreach projects.

Note: Dependents are NOT allowed to accompany FLTAs on this program.

Tentative Program Dates:

From August/September 2017 To May/June 2018 (pending university affiliation)

Review and Selection:

The Fulbright Commission will conduct the initial screening and nomination of applicants. Dossiers of nominated candidates ONLY will be forwarded to the Institute of International Education (IIE) in the U.S. for final selection. Nominations will be based on the candidate's leadership skills, ability to motivate students to learn, and interest in teaching Arabic and Egyptian culture to U.S. students. Final selections and placement of Fulbright FLTA fellows will depend on IIE's ability to match the requests of U.S. host institutions with the language skills of the applicant pool.

Eligibility Requirements

- Young teachers or teachers in training of English as a second language (ESL), or of American studies, literature, and journalism and media studies.
- Bachelor's degree.
- Fluency in spoken and written English with a minimum Institutional (Local-ITP) TOEFL score of 550 from AMIDEAST Egypt or any of the ETS approved centers listed below, Internet-based TOEFL (IBT) score of 79-80, or overall International English Language Testing System (IELTS) score of 6.0.

General Requirements

- ✦ Applicants must clearly demonstrate maturity, dependability, integrity and professionalism.
- ✦ Applicants must be residing in Egypt throughout the nomination and selection process.
- ✦ FLTA applicants must return to their home countries upon completion of the nine-month program.
- ✦ Applicants must have a sincere interest in teaching their native language and culture to American students.
- ✦ Applicants should demonstrate through their application knowledge of their culture and current events in their home country.
- ✦ Computer literacy.
- ✦ Leadership skills, the ability to motivate students and the ability to relate to them in an emphatic manner.
- ✦ Ideally, FLTAs are outgoing, dynamic individuals, flexible, and eager to meet people and become part of the host institution community.
- ✦ An applicant who is seeking a post-graduate U.S. degree should **NOT** apply to the FLTA program.

Funding:

Selected candidates receive a monthly stipend, accident and sickness coverage, and round-trip international travel ticket. U.S. host institutions provide tuition waivers to support the required coursework.

Application Instructions

1. Online applications must be submitted no later than 4:30 p.m. on July 3, 2016. Applications must be completed online in accordance with the instructions noted in the application online module at the following link: <https://apply.embark.com/student/fulbright/flta/> by the deadline.
2. Hard copy of the application together with the supporting documents must be submitted no later than 4:30p.m.on July 3, 2016.

Paper Application Package: All applicants are required to submit the following documents at the Fulbright office at 21 Amer St., Mesaha, Dokki:

1. Four duplicates of the printout of the online **submitted** application;
2. Printout of the confirmation sheet produced after submitting the online application
3. Original official university certificate and transcripts in English (subjects and grades of all university years);
4. Three letters of reference (form is under Supplemental Forms at the online application link). Online recommendations can also be submitted instead;
5. Original valid Institutional (Local-ITP) TOEFL score with a minimum of 550 from AMIDEAST or any approved center as listed above, an Internet-based TOEFL (IBT) score of 79-80, or an overall International English Language Testing System (IELTS) score of 6.0.
6. Detailed C.V. with clear contact information.
7. One recent passport size photo stapled on the front page of one of the copies of the application form.

BOTH online and paper applications are mandatory

FOREIGN LANGUAGE TEACHING ASSISTANT PROGRAM

PROGRAM GOAL: This program strengthens foreign language instruction of Arabic in Egyptian institutions while providing young Egyptian teachers of English as a second language (ESL), as well as teachers of American studies, literature, and journalism and media studies, with opportunities to refine their skills, increase their English language proficiency and expand their knowledge of American society. FLTA fellows teach a minimum number of Arabic classes at host institutions. They enroll in at least four courses (two per semester), one of which must be in U.S. studies. They also facilitate cultural events, language clubs and language tables in their host institutions.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- Young teachers or teachers in training of English as a second language (ESL), or of American studies, literature, and journalism and media studies.
- Bachelor's degree.
- Fluency in spoken and written English with a minimum Institutional TOEFL (Local TTP) score of 550, or its IBT, CBT or IELTS equivalent.

GRANT DURATION: three to nine months.
