- This agreement may be terminated by a written notice from either party only after the expiry of a minimum 120 days.
- Unfinished projects at the time of termination are allowed to continue with all the agreed privileges until finished as planned.
- Any conflict arising during the implementation of this agreement may be settled by negotiations.
