

Lens

A 68 year-old farmer complains of gradual painless diminution of vision in his left eye over the past 9 months. His best corrected vision is 6/18 right eye and HM left eye. His examination is significant for a moderate nuclear sclerosis in his right eye and dense cataract in his left eye.





The rest of his examination, including corneal examination, pupillary reaction and a B-scan of his left eye, is within normal limits.

Now he presents with severe pain in his left eye. The eye is injected. The cornea is edematous with shallow AC. IOP pressure is 14 mmHg in the right eye and 37 mmHg in the left eye.
