

Uveitis


A 56-year-old woman presents with a red painful left eye she has had for 3 days. She has been very sensitive to light since the pain began. She denies any trauma. She had past history of difficult breathing. Her examination is significant for a visual acuity of 6/6 OD and 6/36 OS.

Her left eye has ciliary injection. She has cells and flare in the anterior chamber and large “mutton fat” KPs on the corneal endothelium OS. Numerous cells are present in the vitreous and the view of the retina is hazy.
