Attendance

 Any student who exceeds 30% obsentism in clinical rounds will be withheld from attending the clinical exam.

Log book, Self-learning and Attendance

These are three separate issues

a. Attendance:

- i. The students should attend at least 70% of the total clinical training period: **42 days**, so **19 days absence interferes with attending the exam**.
- ii. Students with recurrent nonattendance and those with non-real signatures will be subjected for withdrawal from the clinical exam
- iii. Those how miss or withdrawn from the clinical exam are not allowed to attend the exam any more

b. Log book activities:

- i. It is a tool for long interaction between the student and the staff member
- ii. Each student should fulfill the requirements in the Log book
- iii. Throughout the 10 weeks of the clinical round, students should do their activity and should be evaluated before signing for the activity by all means of evaluation. But putting in mind that subtracting marks is for only activity deficit and not for knowledge deficit
- iv. Each staff member is allowed to sign only for one activity throughout the 10 weeks... we should stop the (signature party) at the end of the clinical round
- v. Log book will be evaluated at the end of clinical round (without oral examination) as shown in the calendar
- vi. Signatures of the staff should be real ones

c. Self-learning activities:

- i. Each student should make one of the activities by the end of the clinical round
- ii. These may include:
 - PowerPoint presentation (not more than 3 students)
 - Essay
 - Wallpaper
 - o Dept statistics
- iii. Students will be subdivided into subgroups
- iv. This small group will be linked to one staff: choose the activity, choose the title, start early the activity and direct them throughout the 10 weeks
- v. Also , this staff will direct this group for proper management of the log book activities (but again only one signature for one activity is allowed for each staff member)

Course Specifications

Overall Aims of Course

The general aim of the course is to provide students with knowledge, skills and attitudes necessary to make an essential Obstetrics and Gynecology framework of the general practitioner including awareness of the common Obstetrics and Gynecology emergencies. In addition, the students will be acquainted with the main activities of scientific research and community service provided by the department.

Intended Learning Outcomes of Course (ILOs)

a- Knowledge and Understanding:

a.1.Obstetrics:

By the end of this course the student (the learner) will be able to:

- a.1.3. Recognize the various complications in early pregnancy including abortion, molar pregnancy and ectopic pregnancy and recognize various complications in late pregnancy.
- a.1.4.Describe the various causes of antepartum hemorrhage, their diagnosis and management.
- a.1.5. Enlist the various medical disorders complicating pregnancy and their management.
- a.1.6.Recognize different hypertension related disorders related to pregnancy, their risk factors, prevention of complications and their management.
- a.1.8.Identify the normal and abnormal human parturition and its management.
- a.1.10. Enlist the different complications of the third stage of labor and how to manage and how to resuscitate new born and describe normal and abnormal perpuerium
- a.1.11.Identify the different types of fetal injuries that may occur during labor. Get insight into the etiology, mechanism, types, diagnosis and treatment of common Obstetric injuries (pelvic floor trauma, urinary injuries, rectal injuries and rupture uterus).
- a.1.12. Memorize of the different causes of maternal & neonatal mortality, especially in Egypt and how to prevent.
- a.1.13.Review the different operative interventions in obstetrics and knowledge of the different drugs use (analgesia and anesthesia)

a.2. Gvnecology:

By the end of this course the student (the learner) will be able to:

- a.2. 2. Enlist the common genital anomalies that affect the genital tract and describe a summary of their treatments.
- a.2. 3. Enlist the common diseases affecting the genital tract.
- a.2. 4. Enumerate the various causes of genital tract infection, common pathogens and common infection routes and risk factors.
- a.2. 5. Knowledge of the different sexually transmitted diseases, their mode of infection, their prevention, diagnosis and management.
- a.2. 7. Describe the different causes of abnormal uterine bleeding and how to diagnose and manage.
- a.2. 8. Knowledge of the different causes of male and female infertility, how to diagnose and manage.
- a.2. 9. Describe the various types of tumors affecting the genital system, the etiology, pathology, diagnosis and treatment.
- a.2. 10.Enumerate the groups of symptoms of the genitor-urinary tract.
- a.2. 11. Identify the different aspects of pelvic floor function and its disorders.
- a.2. 12.Recognize the different methods and indications of contraception.
- a.2. 13.Get insight into the mechanism and treatment of gynecologic emergencies.
- a.2. 14.Enumerate the different problems of female breast and how to reach a diagnosis and management.
- a.2. 15.Get insight into the reproductive medicine and women's health.
- a.2. 16.Get insight into the common uses of laparoscopy in Obstetrics and Gynecology; both diagnostic and therapeutic.
- a.2. 17. Enumerate the different uses of ultrasound in Obstetrics and Gynecology.

b- Intellectual Skills

By the end of this course the student (the learner) will be able to:

b.1. Integrate basic biomedical science with clinical care of gynecologic and obstetric patients

- b.2. Reason deductively in solving clinical problems related to the gynecologic, reproductive and obstetric medicine:
- b.3. Use personal judgment for analytical and critical problem solving.
- b.4. Integrate the results of history, physical and laboratory test findings into a meaningful diagnostic formulation.
- b.5. Construct appropriate management strategies for patients with gynecologic reproductive and obstetric diseases, both acute and chronic, including medical, psychiatric, and surgical conditions.
- b.6. Design an initial course of management for stabilization of patients with serious illnesses.
- b.7. Classify factors that place individuals at risk for disease or injury, to determine strategies for appropriate response.

c-Professional and Practical Skills

By the end of this course the student (the learner) will be able to:

- cl. Take focused history in a patient complaining of an obstetric and gynecologic complaint.
- c2. Perform effective communication with the patient and the tutor.
- c3. Recognize criteria of life threatening situations in Obstetrics and Gynecology.
- c4. Observe how a patient in the outpatient clinic is interviewed and examined.
- c5. Do obstetric grips examination.
- c6. Recognize fetal heart sounds by Pinard's stethoscope and sonicaid.
- c7. Differentiate the normal and abnormal colposcopic findings.
- c8. Observe normal vaginal delivery.
- c9. Observe cesarean section delivery.
- c10. Interpret the hysterosalpingogram and semen analysis for infertile couples.
- c11. Identify the equipments used in the Obstetrics and Gynecology department: theatre, outpatient and inpatient.
- c12. Assess the mental state of the patient
- c13. Record patients 'data appropriately.
- c14. Formulate a management plan for common gynecologic reproductive and obstetric diseases and acute emergencies.
- c15. Adopt suitable measures for infection control.
