The Gynecological Oncology Unit at Mansoura University, in cooperation with the Department of Woman's Health and Midwifery Nursing, organized a Training course, which is the first to train gynecological nurses on everything related to nursing care for a gynecological oncology patient.

This is under the patronage of Prof. Dr. Sherif Khater - President of Mansoura University, Prof. Dr. Ashraf Shoma - Dean of the Faculty of Medicine, Prof. Dr. Amina Al-Nimr - Dean of the Faculty of Nursing, Prof. Dr. Tamer Abu Al-Saad - Vice Dean of the Faculty of Medicine for Postgraduate Studies and Research. Prof. Dr. Ghada Al-Qunaishi - Vice Dean of the College of Medicine for Community Care and environmental Service, Prof. Dr. Muhammad Al-Najiri - Head of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology, Prof. Dr. Hanan Al-Sayed - Head of the Department of Women's Health and midwifery Nursing - College of Nursing Professor Dr. Amina El-Nemr - Dean of the Faculty of Nursing, Mansoura University, presented the first interactive session with gynecological oncology nursing and faculty members of the Department of Women's Health and midwifery Nursing and trained them on how to evaluate the patient's health, how to provide health awareness and advice, and how to make a follow-up plan after leaving the center to complete Treatment plan and overcoming side effects of treatment, whether chemical, radiological, or surgical. Her Excellency pointed out the importance of providing psychological support to women by listening to them and their problems and trying to reach with them an appropriate solution to the problems they may face during the treatment journey.

Professor Dr. Reda Hamida, Professor of Obstetrics and Gynecology, Director of Obstetrics and Gynecology Clinics at Mansoura University Hospital, and Head of the Gynecology Unit, spoke. On the importance of cooperation between nursing and hospital nursing faculty members to provide them with training expertise in how to deal with a gynecological oncology patient. His Excellency also pointed out the importance of nursing specialization in such nursing care, which includes increasing numbers of patients.

For his part, Professor Dr. Rafik Barakat - Professor of Obstetrics and Gynecology, Head of the Gynecology Unit in Mansoura and Supervisor of Outpatient Clinics, explained the importance of such specialized training courses for nursing, which

lead to improving nursing care for patients and job satisfaction for nurses by renewing their information and various nursing skills .

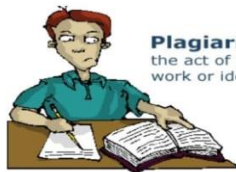




The Department of Woman's Health and Midwifery Nursing organized a workshop on how to avoid plagiarism at the Faculty of Nursing, Mansoura University:

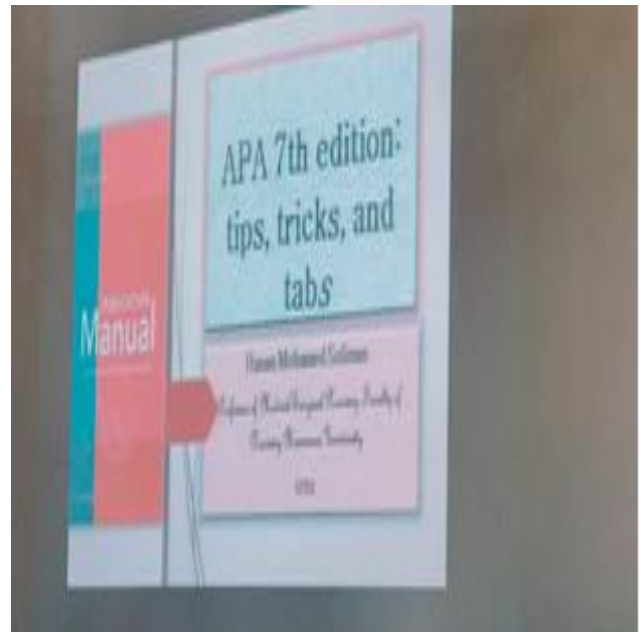
Under the supervision of the Department of Women's Health and midwifery Nursing, headed by Prof. Dr. Hanan Al-Sayed Mohammadi, and present at the

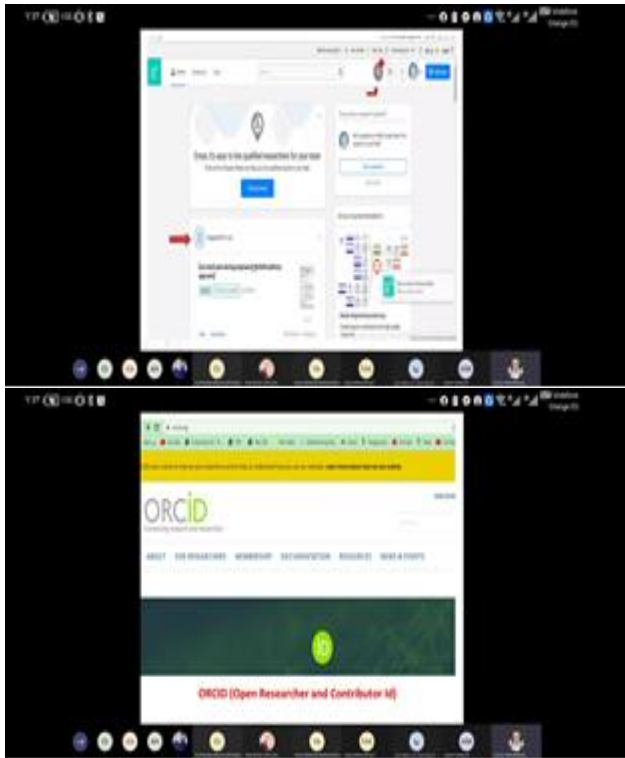

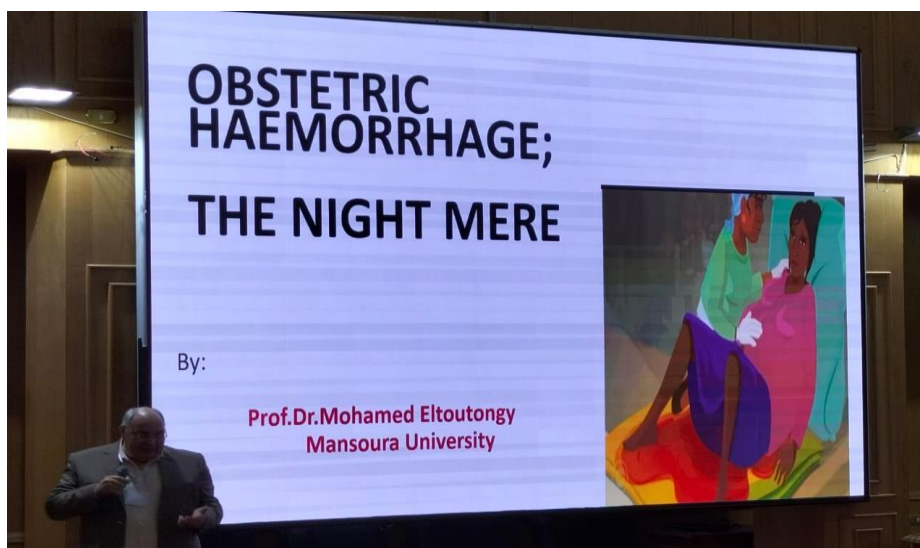
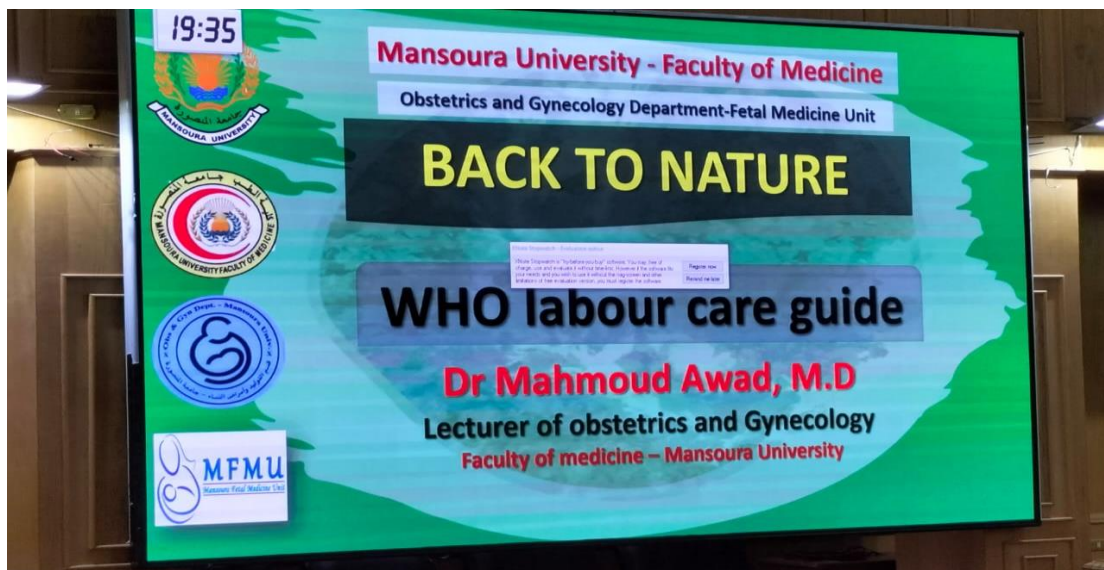
