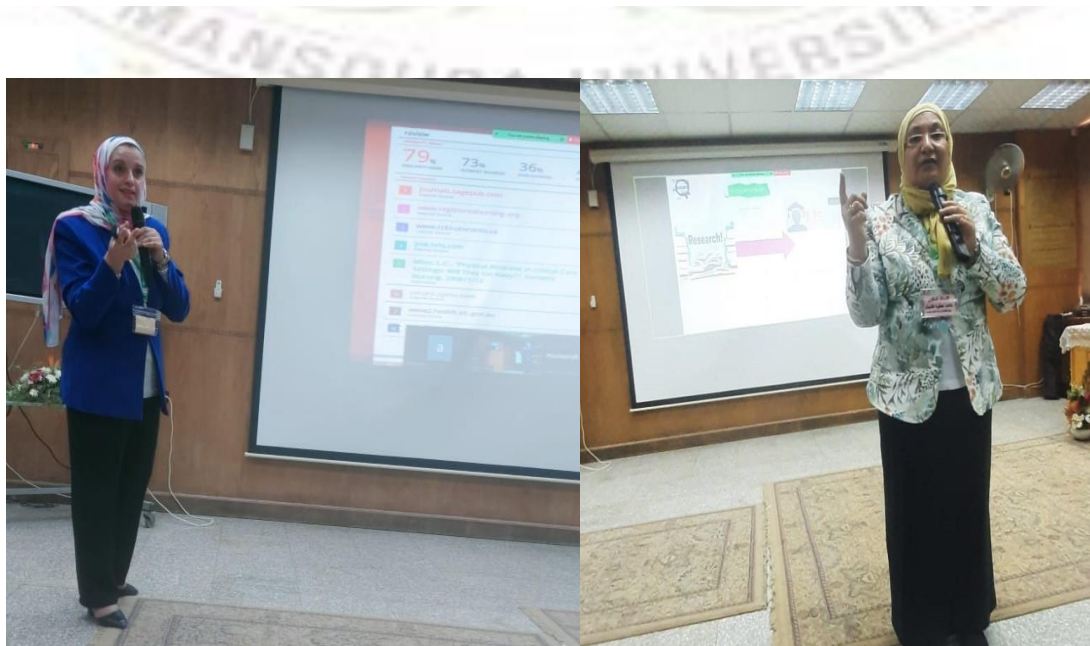


Participation of the Department of Critical Care and Emergency Nursing in the introductory meeting for postgraduate studies

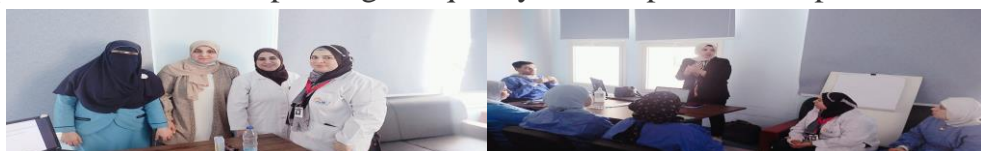

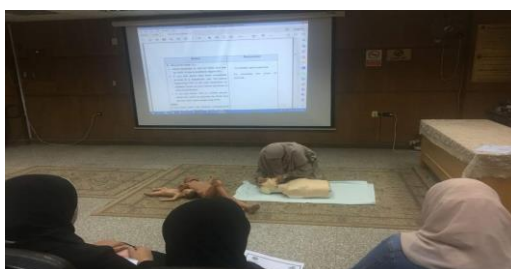
