Abstract text should be 80 - 150 words prepared in MS Word format in Times New Roman and single line spacing may be submitted via E-mail to the conference secretariat before Oct. 1, 2012. Faxes will not be accepted.

- Title centered with the first letter in each word capitalized in 16pt
- Author's names with initials first and comma (,) between them, in one line, presenting author is underlined in 14pt
- Full address and affiliation in 12pt *Italics*. Use Arabian superscript numeration for co-authors with different affiliations or addresses
- Text in 12pt
- References (if any) cited by name and date, not by number
- References at end: no titles; author's (initials first), year, citation
- Figures and undefined acronyms will not be accepted
- Structures and schemes should be minimized. The abstract must lie entirely within 12.5 cm (width) by 17.5 cm (height).

- Pre-registration April. 1, 2012
- Submission of Abstracts Oct. 1, 2012
- Early registration and payments Dec. 1, 2012
- Notification of acceptance Nov. 15, 2012
- Full text submission (provided in the second announcement)
