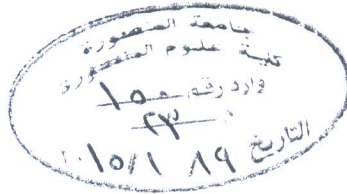

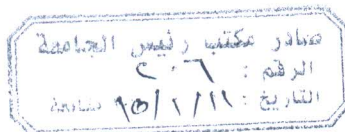

Paper Submission:

Papers should be submitted electronically via the conference's EasyChair submission page. Paper authors may choose between two formats: Full papers (6 pages max) and short papers (4 pages max) following "IEEE standard formatting guidelines". Both formats will be included in the proceedings and will be presented at the conference. Papers will be presented in 15 minutes with 5 minutes for questions and discussion. Short papers typically will be presented in 10 minutes with 5 minutes for questions and discussion. Both formats will be rigorously peer reviewed. Complete papers are required – abstracts and incomplete papers will not be reviewed. Full papers report on mature work, or efforts that have reached an important milestone for the industry. Short papers will highlight efforts that might be in an early stage, but are important for the industry to be made aware of.

Workshop Submission:

Workshops are intended to draw together communities of interest – both those in established communities and those interested in discussion and exploration of a new or emerging issue. They can range in format from formal, perhaps centering on presentation of refereed papers, to informal, perhaps centering on an extended round-table discussions among the selected participants. Submissions should include: a workshop title and short description, a statement of objectives for the workshop, a topical outline for the workshop, identification of the expected audience and expected number of attendees; a description of the planned format and duration (half-day, full-day, or one and a half day), information about how the attendees will be identified, notified of the workshop and, if necessary, selected from among applicants; as well as contact and biographical information about the organizers.
