Program Goal

Provides fully-funded master's degree grants for university graduates to study in the U.S. for a maximum of two years.

All Fields are Eligible.

Eligibility Criteria

- Egyptian citizenship.
- Currently residing in Egypt; applicants must reside in Egypt starting from the application process and throughout the selection, placement and pre-departure processes.
- Bachelor's degree. Minimum of "Good" for applicants in the humanities and social sciences. Minimum of "Very Good" for applicants in the sciences.
- Proof of English Language proficiency.
